On Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays from 29 May to 25 September, you can reach a wide area of North Wales by using the Clwydian Ranger leisure bus network of services.

The ever-popular Loggerheads Country Park, an excellent destination in its own right, continues to be the focal point of a number of services from surrounding towns, interconnecting to offer onward travel to a variety of places within the Clwydian Range Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

Two more scenic services link Rhyl and Prestatyn with Llangollen, Bala and Barmouth calling at Llyn Brenig and Betws y Coed giving access to the Snowdon Sherpa network.

The Coastrider links Wrexham and Mold with the seaside resorts of Rhyl and Prestatyn allowing a full day at the beach. It passes through Bodfari which is one of several access points to the Offa's Dyke Path on the Clwydian Ranger network.

All this and more is available to Clwydian Day Ranger Ticket holders on Sundays with Adult tickets cost just £3.50 with reductions for children and those over 60 whilst Cerdyn Cymru Passholders travel free. Showing your Clwydian Day Ranger Ticket at one of several venues (see page 23) will help you save even more!

Some suggestions for days out...

These trips are designed to whet your appetite - they're a very small sample of what's possible.



Cerrydrudion From Chester (and Merseyside)

Take the Orange Line to Loggerheads Country Park and then the White Line for a scenic circular tour of the Clwydian Range via Ruthin. Choose between a quick half hour stop at Ruthin or 2½ hours to explore the town more fully, perhaps visiting *Ruthin Gaol* (show your Clwydian Ranger ticket for a discount). Return home by continuing on the White Line to Loggerheads Country Park connecting with the Orange Line back to Chester.

From Deeside

Catch the Orange Line from Queensferry, Shotton or Connah's Quay to Moel Famau Forest Car Park. Walk by pleasant footpaths or lanes to Llanferres and perhaps have lunch at the *Druid Inn* (show your Clwydian Ranger ticket for a discount). Return to Loggerheads Country Park on the White Line at 1446 to enjoy some time at this delightful country park before returning home on the Orange Line.

From Flint

You don't have to go far to have a relaxing day out. Catch the Red Line bus to Loggerheads Country Park. You can get refreshments in the Park or visit the nearby *We Three Loggerheads Inn* (show your Clwydian Ranger ticket for a discount). Continue at 1305 on the White Line to Cilcain from where you can walk back to Loggerheads Country Park via the Leete Path (leaflet available at Loggerheads Country Park). Return to Flint on the Red Line.

From Prestatyn

Take the Green Line to Llyn Brenig. Time to take the 10 mile walk around the lake or to search for red squirrels in the surrounding forests. Refreshments available at the Visitor Centre.

From Rhyl

Catch the Purple Line to Betws y Coed and change there to the Sherpa Service S2 to Pen y Pass and the connecting Sherpa Service S1 for the short but dramatic run down through Nant Peris to Llanberis. You can have over 5 hours here before returning the same way. Return earlier to Betws y Coed to enjoy two fascinating towns in one trip.

From Wrexham

Take the X94 service to Bala or stay on the bus to Llanuwchllyn at the far end of the lake from where you can catch the Bala Lake Railway back to Bala. To enjoy a different route home, catch the Green Line to Rhyl. The same bus continues to Wrexham via Mold as the Coastrider.

From Mold

Take the Coastrider to Rhyl or Prestatyn for up to 8 hours at the coast. Return the same way. Go to Prestatyn on 18 June and you could enjoy the guided walk to see the little terns on Barkby Beach (page 22). *The Coastrider runs every day in Summer - please see separate publicity.*

From Ruthin

Take the Blue Line for the scenic run to Llangollen. You have 3¾ hours in this delightful riverside town before returning the same way. *Plas Newydd*, about 15 minutes walk from the centre, and *Llangollen Cycle Hire* both give discounts on production of your Clwydian Ranger ticket.

From Denbigh

Catch the Green Line directly to Barmouth. Return the same way. Enjoy 3½ hours at the coast.

From Betws-y-Coed

Catch the Purple Line to Cerrydrudion and change to the Green Line to Bala. You can have up to 3½ hours in this pleasant lakeside town before continuing to Llangollen where you will have 2 hours or more to enjoy the town before returning home directly on the Purple Line or Service 19.

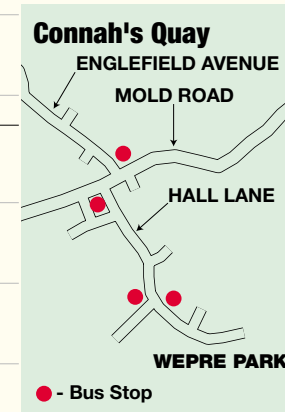

WEPRE COUNTRY PARK

Explore this delightful country park, situated in Connah's Quay, about 10 minutes walk from the Clwydian Ranger Orange Line route - see map above. 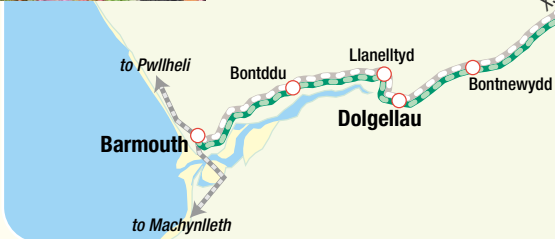

Snowdonia

The Purple Line route to Betws y Coed opens up a whole host of possible trips for walkers and sightseers alike. Betws y Coed itself has plenty to see - ask at the Tourist Information Centre for leaflets of local walks which lead alongside fast flowing rivers, past waterfalls and up into the surrounding forests.

By using connecting Sherpa Bus Services, however, you can travel even deeper into the beautiful Snowdonia Mountain Range. Service S6 will take you to Llyn Ogwen. This is great base for the adventurous walker. For the less energetic, the walk to the Devil's Kitchen will provide a taste of the high mountain scenery with less of the effort.

S2 travels up to Pen y Pass where there is a café and the start of one of the most popular tracks up Snowdon via Crib Goch. At 1,085 metres, however, this is not for the faint hearted and you should have adequate equipment. There is also a connecting service S1 for the short run down the narrow defile of Nant Peris to Llanberis, a delightfully situated town with two narrow gauge railways amongst its many attractions.

Also change at Pen y Pass to the S4 for the scenic journey to Beddgelert, a lovely village with information centre, local riverside walks, shops and cafés, or catch the occasional S97 directly to Beddgelert from Betws y Coed.

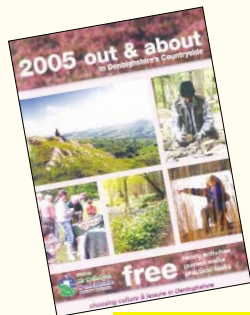
